LOCAL 250 SHORTLINE CONTRACT EXTENSION

Effective May 1st, 2021 to April 30th, 2022


To all Local 250 Pipeline Brothers and Sisters,

This is to notify you that we have negotiated a one-year contract extension. Our contractors and customers have asked for a freeze on wages this year due to covid-19 pandemic and uncertain market.


The four Locals that represent this contract, (Local 250, Local 342, Local 246, and Local 460), have asked for all benefits to be covered for the year and to raise the subsistence pay. We negotiated \$1.30 per hour to cover all benefits. The subsistence pay increased \$15.00 per day, as follows. For welders and journeymen, from \$110.00 to \$125.00 per day, and for helpers, from \$75.00 to \$90.00 per day.

Due to the uncertainty of this last year, we hope you understand that this was not a good year to sit down and negotiate a new contract. In ten months, we will renegotiate your new contract, and are hopeful to meet with the members, prior to negotiations, for your input. The last contract was a four (4) year contract with an overall increase of 13.5%.


